Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion at the Crossroads of Translational Science

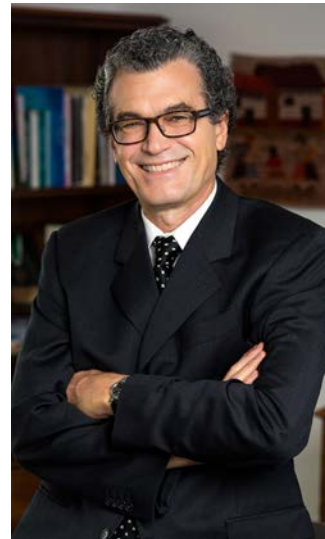
